

Tentative Itinerary



DAY 1 - ARRIVAL

Arrive into Arizona and make your way to the hotel for check-in. After settling in, the remainder of the day is at leisure — perfect for exploring historic Route 66 in Williams, browsing local shops, or enjoying a relaxed dinner at one of the town's classic roadside restaurants. In the evening, we gather for a Welcome Reception to officially begin the Weekender experience and connect as a group.

DAY 2 - GRAND CANYON

Today begins with a scenic journey aboard the historic Grand Canyon Railway departing from Williams.

Upon arrival at the Grand Canyon, we continue with a guided motorcoach tour along the South Rim. This 2.5-hour experience takes you to several of the canyon's most recognizable viewpoints.

A hot buffet lunch inside Grand Canyon National Park is included before returning to Williams by train later in the day.

DAY 3 - SEDONA WINE TOUR

Today we travel to Sedona (1.5 hours one way) for a guided wine tour through Arizona's scenic Verde Valley wine region. Surrounded by red rock landscapes and rolling vineyards, this emerging wine destination offers a relaxed and unique tasting experience.

Throughout the day, we'll visit several local wineries known for their desert-grown varieties and intimate tasting rooms. Enjoy the opportunity to sample regional wines while taking in the beautiful scenery that makes this part of Arizona so distinctive.

DAY 4 - HISTORIC ROUTE 66 TOUR

Today we explore the legendary Route 66, one of America's most iconic highways. This guided experience takes us through historic towns and classic roadside landmarks that capture the spirit of the Mother Road.

Grand Canyon South Rim Guided Tour with Lunch

Upon arrival at the Grand Canyon, continue with a 2.5-hour guided motorcoach tour along the South Rim. This experience takes you to several of the canyon's most recognizable viewpoints while your guide shares insights into the canyon's geology and history. A hot buffet lunch inside Grand Canyon National Park is included.

Verde Valley Wine Tour from Sedona
