Country Overview

The Andes form the spine of neighbouring Bolivia and Peru, and they plunge down to a landscape of valleys, terraced farmland, Inca ruins and harsh desert, dotted with colonial cities and indigenous villages. These two countries are home to some of South America's most beautiful sights, so it makes sense to combine both of them on a single trip, and yet many people just, well, don't.



Cusco, Peru (4 nights)

The region around Machu Picchu, including the Sacred Valley, Inca Trail and colonial city of Cusco, is rich in archaeological sites.

La Paz, Bolivia (1 night)

La Paz, in Bolivia, is the highest administrative capital in the world, resting on the Andes' Altiplano plateau at more than 3,500m above sea level. It stretches to El Alto city in the highlands, with snow-capped, 6,438m-high Mt. Illimani as its backdrop. The city's dramatic setting can be taken in during rides on Mi Teleférico, the aerial cable car system

Uyuni, Bolivia (3 nights)

Bolivia's Salar de Uyuni is considered one of the most extreme and remarkable vistas in all of South America, if not Earth. Stretching more than 4,050 square miles of the Altiplano, it is the world's largest salt flat, left behind by prehistoric lakes that evaporated long ago.

Tentative Itinerary



DAY 1 - ARRIVAL

Upon arrival into Cusco, you will be transported via one of our group transfer times to our hotel. Look for our driver in the arrivals hall after collecting your luggage.

After check-in, take the rest of the afternoon at leisure to unwind from the long flight, explore the area around the hotel, or enjoy your first evening in Cusco. In the evening, we will gather for a Welcome Dinner to officially begin the trip and connect as a group.

DAY 2 - CUSCO CITY TOUR

Today, after breakfast, we leave for our Cusco city tour.

We will explore the City of the Incas while walking along cobblestoned streets lined with Inca and Colonial architecture. Highlights include the Cathedral in Plaza de Armas, Qoricancha Sun Temple, San Pedro Market, and the impressive ruins of Sacsayhuamán and Qenko located above the city.

Throughout the day, you will have the opportunity to experience the charm of Cusco while learning more about its importance as the former capital of the Inca Empire.

DAY 3 - MACHU PICCHU

After breakfast, we head to Machu Picchu, one of the Seven Wonders of the World. We will take the train to Aguas Calientes, passing through the valleys that lead to the Lost City of the Incas. Upon arrival, we will tour the ceremonial center, cultivation terraces, guard house, Main Temple, Sacred Plaza, Temple of the Three Windows, and Intihuatana stone. This will be a full day of exploring one of the world's most iconic archaeological sites before returning later in the day.

Meal(s) Included: Breakfast, Lunch

DAY 4 - SACRED VALLEY

Today, after breakfast, we will enjoy a tour of the Sacred Valley. Stops include the Pisac Archaeological Site, Pisac Market, Ollantaytambo Archaeological Site, and Chinchero Archaeological Site. This region once formed the heart of the Inca Empire and remains one of Peru's most important cultural areas.

Meal(s) Included: Breakfast, Lunch



DAY 5 - DEPART FOR LA PAZ

Today we depart from Cusco and make our way to La Paz. Due to logistics, we will spend one night in the city before continuing to Uyuni.

After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will transfer to the airport for our flight. The flight from Cusco to La Paz is approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes, not including airport processing and transfer time.

Upon arrival into La Paz, we will transfer to our hotel for check-in. The remainder of the evening is yours to relax, enjoy dinner.

DAY 6 - DEPART FOR UYUNI

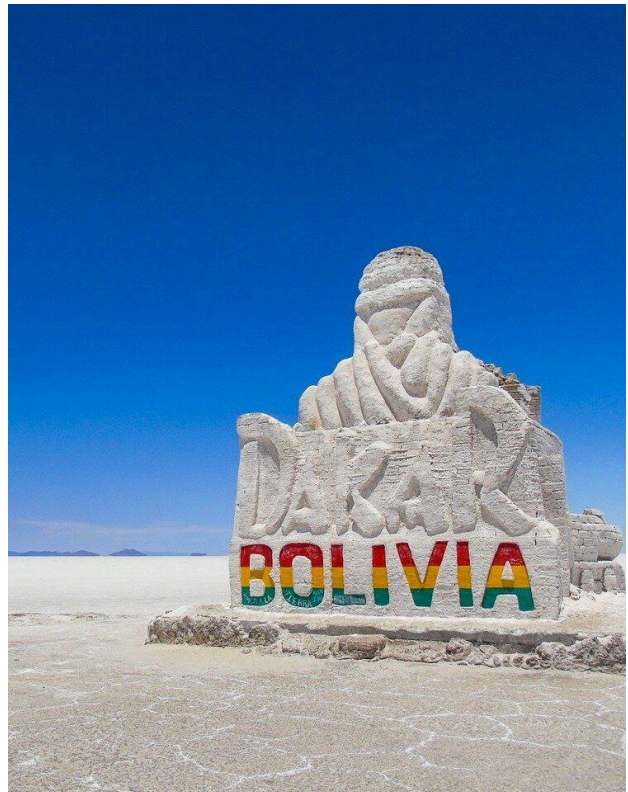
This morning, we enjoy a brief tour of La Paz before continuing our journey to Uyuni.

La Paz is known for its dramatic mountain setting, colorful markets, and position as one of the highest cities in the world. Depending on timing, we may explore local markets, scenic viewpoints, or parts of the city center before transferring to the airport.

Later, we will board our domestic flight to Uyuni. The flight from La Paz to Uyuni is approximately 1 hour.

Upon arrival, we will transfer to our hotel for check-in. The remainder of the evening is yours to relax and prepare for our upcoming Salt Flats experience.

DAY 7 - VISIT THE SALT FLATS

Today we explore the breathtaking Salar de Uyuni, one of the most surreal landscapes in the world.

Our first stop will be the Train Cemetery, where old locomotives from the late 19th century sit abandoned in the desert. We then continue to the village of Colchani, where local artisans create handicrafts and process salt collected from the flats.

As we venture deeper into the Salar, we will stop to see salt extraction sites, salt eyes, and the famous Playa Blanca Salt Hotel, which now functions as a museum.

Later, we visit Incahuasi Island, located in the middle of the salt flats. This island is known for its giant cacti, fossilized rock formations, and panoramic views across the endless white landscape.

After a full day of exploring, photographing, and taking in the scenery, we return to Uyuni in the evening.

Meal(s) Included: Breakfast

DAY 8 - HOT SPRINGS & HIGHLANDS TOUR

Today we continue exploring the landscapes surrounding Uyuni. After breakfast, we depart for the village of Pulacayo, once home to one of Bolivia's most important silver mining centers. We will also visit the historic locomotives that transported ore through the region during the late 1800s. From there, we continue through the Bolivian highlands toward the hot springs, where you will have time to relax in the mineral-rich thermal waters surrounded by mountain scenery. Later, we visit the Warmi and Verde lagoons, where you can admire the wildlife and landscapes of the Altiplano before stopping for lunch.

Our final stop of the day will be the colonial church of Tomave before returning to Uyuni in the evening.

Meal(s) Included: Breakfast , Lunch, Dinner



DAY 9 - DEPART FOR LA PAZ

After breakfast, we will check out of our hotel and transfer to the airport for our return flight to La Paz. The flight from Uyuni to La Paz is approximately 1 hour.

Important: This trip officially ends upon arrival into La Paz airport. We recommend not booking your return flight until our team confirms the final domestic flight schedule closer to departure. **Meal(s) Included:** Breakfast

4-Star Hotel Accommodations:

(4-nights in Cusco) - Our hotel in Cusco is located near the city center, providing convenient access to the Plaza de Armas, restaurants, shops, and many of the city's historic attractions.

(1-night in La Paz) - Our hotel in La Paz offers a comfortable overnight stay before continuing on to Uyuni, with convenient access to the airport and local attractions.

(3-nights in Uyuni) - Our Uyuni hotel offers a unique stay in one of Bolivia's most remarkable landscapes, serving as the perfect base for exploring the Salt Flats and surrounding highlands.

Cusco City Tour - Explore the historic streets of Cusco while visiting key landmarks including Plaza de Armas, the Cathedral, Qoricancha Sun Temple, San Pedro Market, Sacsayhuamán, and Qenko.

Sacred Valley Tour - The Sacred Valley was once the heart of the Inca Empire and remains one of Peru's most important cultural regions. This experience includes visits to Pisac Archaeological Site, Pisac Market, Ollantaytambo, and Chinchero.

Machu Picchu - Travel by train to Aguas Calientes before exploring one of the Seven Wonders of the World. Tour the ceremonial center, terraces, Main Temple, Sacred Plaza, Temple of the Three Windows, and Intihuatana stone.

Salar de Uyuni Tour - Explore the world's largest salt flat, including stops at the Train Cemetery, Colchani village, salt extraction sites, Playa Blanca Salt Hotel, and Incahuasi Island.

Hot Springs & Highlands Tour - Visit Pulacayo Village, historic locomotives, the hot springs, Warmi and Verde lagoons, and the colonial church of Tomave while experiencing Bolivia's dramatic highland landscapes.

Meals Included - Meals as listed in above itinerary.

Domestic Flights - One-way domestic flights from Cusco to La Paz, La Paz to Uyuni, and Uyuni back to La Paz are included. Economy Class.

Airport Transfers - Round trip airport transfers on the start and end dates of tour from Cusco airport.
