## Country Overview

Seychelles offers you the world's best beaches. Located almost 1,000 miles off of mainland East Africa, the Seychelles has always been a dream destination of many. With pristine white-sand beaches, lush forests, and dramatic mountains, this place is a true tropical paradise.

The Seychelles is an archipelago of 115 islands in the Indian Ocean. It's home to numerous beaches, coral reefs and nature reserves, as well as rare animals such as giant Aldabra tortoises. Mahé, a hub for visiting the other islands, is home to capital Victoria. It also has the mountain rainforests of Morne Seychellois National Park and beaches, including Beau Vallon and Anse Takamaka.



### Mahe, Seychelles (5 nights)

Mahé is the largest island in the Seychelles archipelago. With exotic trees lining the beaches for miles, this place is a beach lover's heaven. And there's no shortage of natural beauty in any direction. The island is full of picture-perfect coconut plantations and empty beaches with granite peaks framing it all. It's almost too beautiful for words.

Its terrain is defined by white-sand beaches such as those in the popular resort area of Beau Vallon, and granite peaks including the rainforested Morne Seychellois. The island is also home to Victoria, Seychelles' capital, known for Creole architecture and a colorful covered market with wares like fish, fruit and clothing.

## Tentative Itinerary



### **DAY 1 - ARRIVAL**

Arrive at Victoria-Seychelles International Airport (SEZ). Make your way to the hotel once you touch down into Mahe. If this is your first time traveling outside of the Country reach out to our Trip Support team for suggested airport transfer companies.

After check-in, take the rest of the afternoon at leisure rewinding from the long flight.

**Meal(s) Included:** Dinner

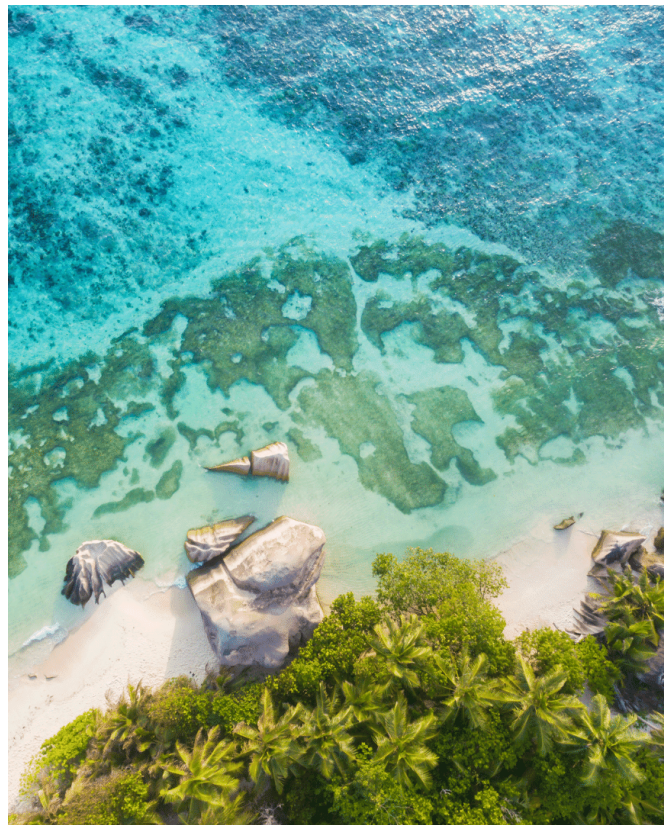
**Hotel Check-In:** 3 PM local time.

### **DAY 2 - MAHE CITY TOUR**

Discover the highlights of Victoria, one of the world's smallest capitals, during this guided city experience. Visit the heart of Victoria, where you'll have the opportunity to see the iconic clock tower, the courthouse, browse local souvenir stalls, and explore the colorful market filled with fresh fruits, vegetables, fish, and spices.

The tour also includes a visit to the Botanical Gardens, one of Seychelles' oldest national monuments dating back over a century, followed by a local rum tasting experience where you'll sample flavors unique to the islands.

### **DAY 3 - PRASLIN ISLAND**

The "Heart of Praslin" is home to remnants of the original palm jungles of the Seychelles and has often been described as a "Garden of Eden" thanks to its secluded and mystical nature. It's possible to follow the traces of prehistory in this pristine jungle area, unchanged for millions of years, and find all six of the endemic palm species that can be found here. The Coco de Mer, the largest seed in the world, is particularly admired by visitors, and is the reason for the National Park's world heritage site status.

The rest of the afternoon is yours to explore or relax at our beautiful hotel.

### **DAY 4 - LA DIGUE ISLAND**

Upon arrival on La Digue island we will be escorted to L'union Estate for the Copra hill, Emmanuel House, vanilla plantation, tortoise pen. We will then proceed to one of the most beautiful beaches, Anse Source D'Argent to swim, snorkel or relax.

## **DAY 5 - BEACH DAY!**

Today, we will enjoy lunch at a local beach front restaurant. After lunch, you will have time to relax and enjoy the beautiful beaches in Mahe, Seychelles.

Situated on the scenic west coast of Mahé in the region of Anse Boileau, Anse Louis is a magnificent, secluded bay shielded from the elements with great wave formations.

After a day of relaxing on the beach, we will head back to our host hotel in Bean Vallou, before heading to our farewell dinner.

## What's Included:

**4 - Star Hotel Accommodations (5-nights in Mahe)** - Your hotel is located on Beau Vallon, the most popular beach on the island of Mahe in Seychelles.

**Rooms** - This cozy guest room overlooking the hotel's garden and green mountains of Mahe island invites you to relax and escape from your daily routine. An elegant bathroom is equipped with a bathtub and a separate shower. A spacious balcony or a terrace is the best place to enjoy your morning cup of coffee. The guest room features individually controlled air-conditioning and free WiFi.

**North Mahe Tour** - Mahé is the largest island in the Seychelles archipelago, in the Indian Ocean off East Africa. Its terrain is defined by white-sand beaches such as those in the popular resort area of Beau Vallon, and granite peaks including the rainforested Morne Seychellois. The island is also home to Victoria, Seychelles' capital, known for Creole architecture and a colorful covered market with wares like fish, fruit and clothing.

**South Mahe Tour** - The South of Mahe offers travelers unspoiled beaches, countryside and an overall untamed island feel. Start your day in one of the smallest capitals in the world, Victoria. Here you will visit the Little Ben market where you will be able to see the famous Clock Tower. After this you will continue on a scenic drive into the mountains with stunning ocean views towards Mission Lodge, an ancient school that is now used as a home for endemic birds but used to be a school for slave children.

**Praslin Island Visit** - Praslin is an island in the Seychelles, in the Indian Ocean. It's known for palm-fringed beaches, like Anse Georgette and Anse Lazio, both bordered by large granite boulders. The main beach, Anse Volbert-Côte D'Or, faces the offshore islet Chauve Souris. Praslin's rugged, jungle-covered interior is home to Praslin National Park, which encompasses Vallée de Mai Nature Reserve.

**La Digue Island Visit** - La Digue is an island in the Seychelles, in the Indian Ocean off East Africa. It's known for its beaches, like Anse Source d'Argent, dotted with granite boulders, on the west coast. To the south, isolated Anse Bonnet Carré Beach, with calm, shallow water, is accessible only on foot, as is Anse Cocos Beach, in a protected bay on the east coast.
