


Bogota, Colombia (3-nights)

Bogotá, Colombia's capital, is a high-altitude city surrounded by mountains and filled with historic charm. Its La Candelaria district showcases colorful colonial buildings, world-famous museums like the Gold Museum, and lively plazas. Stroll the markets, taste fresh local fruit, take in panoramic city views from Monserrate, and learn about Colombian history and culture firsthand.

Known as the "City of Eternal Spring," Medellín is celebrated for its year-round mild weather, innovative public transit system, and dynamic neighborhoods. From the vibrant murals of Comuna 13 to the iconic sculptures of Botero Square, Medellín is a city transformed—full of stories of resilience, community, and art. Visitors also experience cultural landmarks, local flavors, and a look into one of the most pivotal eras in Colombia's recent history.

Tentative Itinerary



DAY 1 - ARRIVAL

Arrive at El Dorado International Airport, where you will be greeted and transferred to your hotel. After settling in, take time to relax and enjoy the surrounding neighborhood.

In the evening, meet your host and fellow travelers for a welcome dinner featuring authentic Colombian dishes—your introduction to the flavors and warmth of Bogotá.

Hotel Check-In: 3 PM local time.

DAY 2 - BOGOTA CITY TOUR

Begin your exploration of Bogotá in the heart of La Candelaria, the city's historic center. Walk its cobblestone streets, admire colonial architecture, and learn about Bogotá's Indigenous and colonial origins at Chorro de Quevedo.

Continue toward Plaza Bolívar before stopping for a cup of high-quality Colombian coffee. In the afternoon, ride the cable car up to Monserrate for panoramic views of the city. Then explore two of Bogotá's most iconic museums: the Botero and Gold Museum.

DAY 3 - COFFEE FARM EXPERIENCE

Leave Bogotá for a scenic drive to Fusagasugá, a warm Andean town home to the acclaimed Hacienda Coloma coffee farm. Upon arrival, meet your expert coffee guide and explore the hacienda's lush gardens, orchids, and coffee plantations. Learn about the full coffee process—cultivation, harvesting, de-pulping, washing, drying, roasting, and grinding.

Afterward, enjoy a tasting of the farm's coffee and coffee liquor. Continue to Fusagasugá town for a traditional Colombian lunch. This immersive farm-to-cup experience is a guest favorite and one of Colombia's top coffee tours.

DAY 4 - FLY TO MEDELLIN

This morning, take a short domestic flight from Bogotá to Medellín. After checking into your hotel in El Poblado, enjoy free time to relax, explore nearby cafés, or stroll through Provenza's lively streets. In the evening, join the group for dinner to kick off your Medellín experience.

DAY 5 - MEDELLIN CITY TOUR

Start your day with a visit to San Antonio Park, an open-air gallery featuring Botero sculptures. Continue to explore key cultural landmarks, including Palacio de la Cultura Rafael Uribe Uribe and the iconic Botero Square—home to 23 sculptures by the famed Colombian artist.

In the afternoon, head to Comuna 13 for its world-famous graffiti tour. Ride the outdoor escalators, meet local artists, hear stories of the community's transformation, and take in the powerful murals and urban art. Along the way, enjoy traditional local snacks for a full cultural immersion.

DAY 6 - PABLO ESCOBAR TOUR

Learn about one of the most complex chapters in Colombia's history through an in-depth tour following the real story of Pablo Escobar. Visit the neighborhood where he built housing for the poor, explore the sites tied to his imprisonment and escape, and visit the location where he died.

In the evening, gather for a special farewell dinner to celebrate your journey through Colombia.

DAY 7 - DEPART COLOMBIA

After breakfast, transfer to José María Córdova International Airport for your flight home. Depart Colombia with unforgettable memories of its culture, flavors, landscapes, and welcoming people.
