Wellness Travel

Country Overview

Iceland, a Nordic island nation, is defined by its dramatic landscape with volcanoes, geysers, hot springs and lava fields. Massive glaciers are protected in Vatnajökull and Snæfellsjökull national parks. Most of the population lives in the capital, Reykjavik, which runs on geothermal power and is home to the National and Saga museums, tracing Iceland's Viking history.

Iceland has more hot springs and solfataras—volcanic vents that emit hot gasses and vapors—than any other country. Alkaline hot springs are found in some 250 areas throughout the country.



Reykjavik, Iceland (4 nights)

Reykjavik, on the coast of Iceland, is the country's capital and largest city. It's home to the National and Saga museums, tracing Iceland's Viking history. The striking concrete Hallgrimskirkja church and rotating Perlan glass dome offer sweeping views of the sea and nearby hills. Exemplifying the island's volcanic activity is the geothermal Blue Lagoon spa, near the village of Grindavik.

DAY 1 - ARRIVAL

Upon arrival at Reykjavik-Keflavik Airport (KEF), you will head to the arrivals area to meet our driver. After check in, enjoy the rest of the afternoon relaxing from a long flight. Later this evening we will get together for our welcome dinner.

DAY 2 - FOOD & CITY TOUR + 7 RITUAL EXPERIENCE

The beauty of Iceland's cuisine will rival the grandeur and majesty of Iceland's endless, gorgeous landscapes with every bite. DAY 3 - GOLDEN CIRCLE + NORTHERN LIGHTS

The Golden Circle tour lets you see some of Iceland's most incredible natural wonders. From Reykjavik, we will set off to the famous Golden Circle: the scenic journey will take about 40 minutes but don't worry; there are plenty of things to see along the way.

We will begin by visiting the Thingvellir National Park, both steeped in history and stunningly beautiful. There you will see the historic site of Althingi, the location of the world's oldest operational parliament. From Thingvellir, we will move on to the iconic geothermal area around Geysir hot spring: here, you will see the incredible Geysers throw water and steam up to 25 meters into the air.

After Geysir, we will travel to Gullfoss (the Golden Waterfall). After completing our golden circle tour, we will return to our hotel for a quick break for dinner before starting our Northern Lights tour.

Important: Warm outdoor clothing, thermal underwear, waterproof jacket and pants, headwear and winter/snow gloves. Good hiking shoes are also highly recommended.





DAY 4 - BLUE LAGOON & WATER MASSAGE

Golden Circle Tour - The Golden Circle tour gives you the chance to see some of Iceland's most incredible natural wonders. It gives you the opportunity to see the stunningly, unique geology of Thingvellir National Park; pick your way through the Geysir hot spring area; gaze at the golden water of Gullfoss (the Golden Waterfall); and ride a snowmobile across Langjokull Iceland's second biggest glacier.

Our tour focuses on the history of Iceland, the evolution of Reykjavík as a town and Icelandic culture in general.
