
Nairobi, Kenya (5 nights)

Made of open grass plains and scattered acacia bush, the park is home to Africa's Big five—Rhino, Elephant, Lion, Buffalo and Leopard—as well as other hosts of wildlife like Zebras, Antelopes, Giraffes, wildebeest, baboons and birds.

Marsi Mara, Kenya (2 nights)

Maasai Mara is one of the most famous and important wildlife conservation and wilderness areas in Africa, world-renowned for its exceptional populations of lion, leopard, cheetah and African bush elephant.



Meal(s) Included: Dinner


Hotel Check-In: 3 PM local time.
