DAY 1 - ARRIVAL

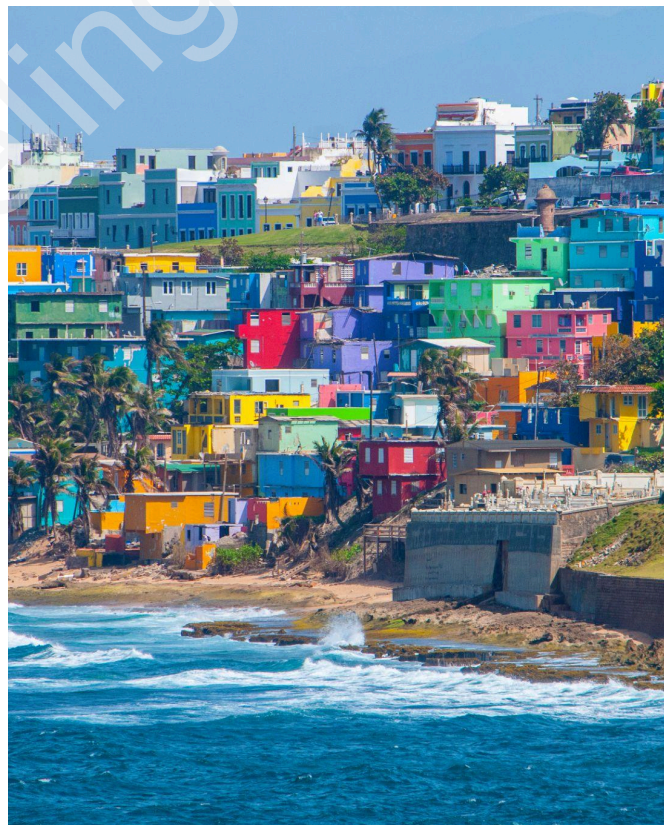
