Rome, Italy (4-nights)

In the evening, we will all get together for a welcome dinner.



DAY 2 - ROME CITY TOUR (PART I)

Today you will visit two of Rome's most iconic attractions – the Colosseum and the Vatican! The Vatican museum is the most visited Museum in Italy displaying the largest art collection of the world including Michelangelo's fresco that adorn the Sistine Chapel. As you delve deeper into the Museums your guide will point out pagan sculptures, massive maps from the middle ages, and the Pope's personal collection of paintings, tapestries, and unique treasures.

Of course, no trip to the Vatican is complete without the Sistine Chapel and you'll get to look up at Michelangelo's magnificent frescoes.





DAY 3 - ROME CITY TOUR (PART II)

Today after breakfast, we will see more of the famous sites in Roma! Let the Eternal City enchant you as you stroll through its picturesque cobblestone alleyways and discover some of the world's most famous sights – all in a single afternoon! We'll see the Trevi Fountain, Pantheon and the Spanish Steps along with many of the city's unsung heroes.

Stops Included: Spanish Steps, Trevi Fountain, Pantheon, Piazza Navona, Emperor Marco Aurelio Column, "Montecitorio" Parliament Palace, Pantheon, Navona Square, Domitian's Emperor Stadium (outside).

DAY 5 - FLY TO CROATIA

Today after breakfast, we will head to the airport as we make our way to Split, Croatia! Split, a town on Croatia's Dalmatian Coast, is known for its beaches and the fortresslike complex at its center, Diocletian's Palace, erected by the Roman emperor in the 4th century. Once home to thousands, its sprawling remains include more than 200 buildings.

Important - Passport copies will be needed to book your domestic flight. This information will be required at least *(5)* **months** prior to the trip departure date.

DAY 6 - BLUE CAVE TOUR

Today you will spend a full day on the sea, visit some of the most beautiful Croatian islands and witness the natural phenomenon of the Blue cave on the Bisevo island.

We will visit 4 beautiful islands (Bisevo, Budikovac, Paklinski and Hvar island) in a single day. We will take you to the places where you couldn't go by ferry.

Note: We are not allowed to enter the Blue Cave with our speedboat; instead, Blue Cave staff will take you on a 15 min ride with small wooden boats. Then you will witness the beauty that amazing glowing blue light creates inside the cave. In addition, our time on each island may range from 1 - 2 hours max.




DAY 7 - PLITVICE LAKES TOUR

After breakfast we will head off for a full day at Plitvice Lakes!

Plitvice National Park is Croatia's most popular national park and, many claim, Europe's most breathtaking natural wonder. Sixteen electric blue Plitvice Lakes inhabit a forested canyon, interconnected by stunning waterfalls, and easy-to-hike boardwalks and trails.

The park has exceptionally rich and varied flora and fauna. Total of 1,267 types of plants belonging to the 109 species have been identified within the park, including 75 endemic species.

This park is home to an amazingly wide variety of animal and bird species such as the European brown bear, wolf, eagle, owl and wild cat. It is one of the last areas in Europe with such a great variety of infauna. You can even find an astonishing number of 321 different butterflies' species.



DAY 8 - FREE DAY

Today is yours to explore Split!

Channel your inner Game of Thrones character and see the famous sites featured in the series, or relax on one of the beautiful beaches of split.

Later this evening we will get together for a farewell dinner.

DAY 9 - DEPART
