Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam (1 night): Ho Chi Minh City is Vietnam's largest city, known for its fast-paced energy, historic landmarks, and vibrant street life. It offers a blend of modern development and deep-rooted history, serving as the gateway to southern Vietnam and the Mekong Delta region.

Hoi An / Da Nang, Vietnam (4 nights): Central Vietnam is home to some of the country's most iconic landscapes and cultural sites. Hoi An, a UNESCO-listed town, is known for its preserved architecture and lantern-lit streets, while nearby Da Nang offers access to Ba Na Hills and the Golden Bridge, set high above the mountains.

Hanoi, Vietnam (3 nights): Hanoi, the capital of Vietnam, is known for its centuries-old architecture and rich culture shaped by Southeast Asian, Chinese, and French influences. Its Old Quarter reflects the city's history through narrow streets, local markets, and everyday life.

Ha Long Bay, Vietnam (Day Experience): Ha Long Bay is a UNESCO World Heritage Site known for its emerald waters and thousands of towering limestone islands topped with rainforest. It is one of Vietnam's most iconic natural landscapes and a highlight of any journey through the country.

Tentative Itinerary



DAY 1 - ARRIVAL

Upon arrival into Ho Chi Minh City, you will be transported via one of our group transfer times to our hotel. Look for our driver in the arrivals hall after collecting your luggage.

After check-in, take the rest of the afternoon at leisure to unwind from the long flight, explore the area around the hotel, or enjoy your first evening. In the evening, we will gather for a Welcome Dinner to officially begin the trip and connect as a group.

DAY 2 - HO CHI MINH CITY TOUR

Begin the day with a brief guided tour of Ho Chi Minh City, exploring its key landmarks, local neighborhoods, and cultural sites that provide insight into Vietnam's history and everyday life.

In the afternoon, transfer to the airport for your flight to Da Nang. Upon arrival, continue by private transfer to Hoi An, where you'll settle into your hotel and begin your time in one of Vietnam's most charming destinations.

DAY 3 - TRANSFER TO HOI AN

This morning, you'll depart Ho Chi Minh City and fly to Da Nang. Upon arrival, a private transfer will take you along the coast to Hoi An, a town known for its preserved architecture and relaxed atmosphere. After checking into your hotel, the remainder of the day is yours to explore at your own pace. You may choose to walk through the town's lantern-lined streets, visit local shops, or simply settle in and enjoy the slower pace of central Vietnam.

DAY 4 - GOLDEN BRIDGE (ICONIC LANDMARK)

Travel to Ba Na Hills for a visit to the Golden Bridge, one of Vietnam's most iconic landmarks. Suspended above the mountains and supported by massive stone hands, the bridge offers sweeping views of the surrounding landscape and is one of the most photographed sites in the country. After exploring the area and taking in the scenery, you'll return to Hoi An for the remainder of the day.

DAY 5 - COOKING CLASS / LANTERN BOAT RIDE

Today offers a deeper connection to Hoi An's culture and traditions. Begin with a hands-on Vietnamese cooking class, where you'll learn about local ingredients and prepare traditional dishes.

In the evening, experience Hoi An from the water with a lantern boat ride along the river. As the sun sets, the town comes alive with glowing lanterns, creating one of the most visually memorable moments of the trip.

DAY 6 - FREE DAY IN HOI AN

DAY 9 - HA LONG BAY DAY CRUISE

Travel to Ha Long Bay, a UNESCO World Heritage Site known for its dramatic limestone formations rising from emerald waters. As you cruise through the bay, you'll take in panoramic views of this natural wonder while experiencing one of Vietnam's most iconic landscapes. The day offers a balance of relaxation and exploration before returning to Hanoi.
